BACKGROUND:

As the Board knows that the Police Chief indicated that he would be willing to consider retirement and his current Employment Contract requires sixty (60) days notice. The Police Chief, his attorney, Attorney Moulton, and the Township Supervisor have put together a Statement of Benefits that would be provided to the current Police Chief upon retirement. That Statement is an extrapolation of the benefits that would be provided pursuant to the existing Employment Agreement of the Current Police Chief and the Township Board made in December 2007. That Agreement incorporates by reference the existing Command Contract.

The Statement had several revisions and was reviewed by Police Chief, his attorney, the Township Supervisor and **ATTORNEY MOULTON**.
